Registration.

Is an important part of our time together. Compregistration form: -

- Helps us get to know the children better.
- It ensures that we are aware of allergies and other relevant information
- It helps us to keep everyone safe.

A registration form is enclosed. If you need more than one, extra copies can be obtained from the Registration Desk in the Information Room to the right of the Sanctuary. If you are visiting you can make a note of that on the top of the form.

Please register your children before the service if possible.

Registration is not a one-off process, please keep us up to date with any additional needs. You can speak to your child's Group Leader in confidence.



LIVE STREAMING

Please be aware our morning services are Livestreamed. This means that services appear on the internet. Before your child comes to the front, they should have your permission.



What to expect:

We begin the morning together as a family in the church. During this time there is singing, a short talk/activity, a voluntary offering and prayer.

We would encourage the children to be involved in all of these acts of worship. The time to leave is announced by the person leading the service.

The timing is not exact, but is usually around 20 minutes after the start of the service.

The end of the morning:

At the end of the morning children are collected by their parents from their respective groups. For Explorers, Adventurers, Navigators and Trailblazers we request that they are collected by somebody over 18.

We aim to finish teaching by 11:45, and ask that all children are collected by 12:00

Emergency Evacuation:

School years 1 to 3 (age 5-8 years) **Navigators** meet in the Memorial Lounge.

School years 4 to 6 (age 8 -11years). Trailblazers meet in the Memorial Hall.











Adventurers, Navigators and Trailblazers all start the morning in church with their families. After a short time, they leave the service and have a time together with refreshments. After this they divide into their separate groups for age-appropriate Bible teaching and activities. At other times such as holidays, the groups may join together.






